R*TIME System Files

- System Files include:
 - System Messages
 - User Messages
 - Alarm Messages
 - SOE Messages
 - 16 System Event Files
- System Files reside in the %RTIMEHOME%\unit\messages\local directory.



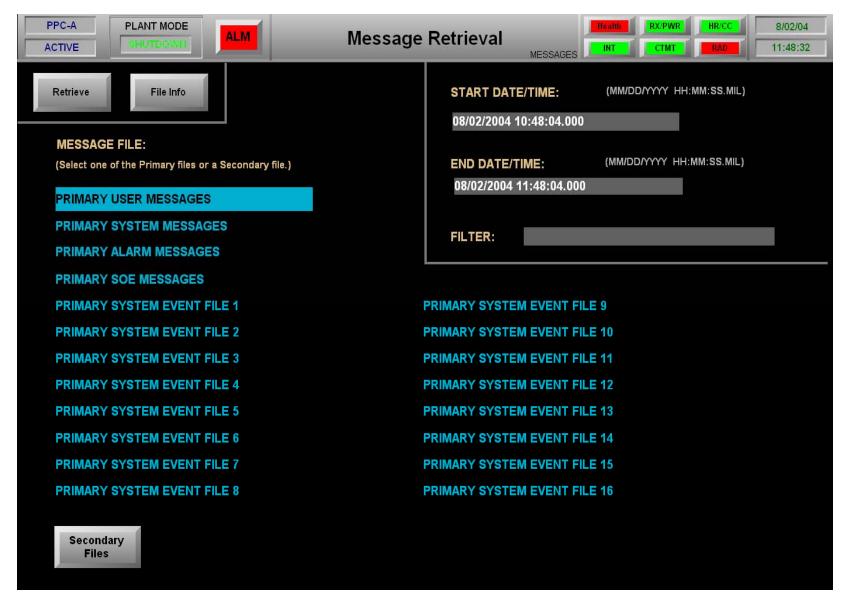


Message Retrieval Display

- Existing Message Retrieval Display
 - Requires user action for any output.
 - Report driven output.











Dynamic Message Summary Display

- Dynamic Message Retrieval Display Features
 - Dynamically updates the display based on new messages.
 - Allows user to filter data by time, string, and file.
 - Allows user to sort messages chronologically or reverse chronologically.
 - Allows user to create a printable report of the displayed data.
 - Allows paging through the displayed messages.



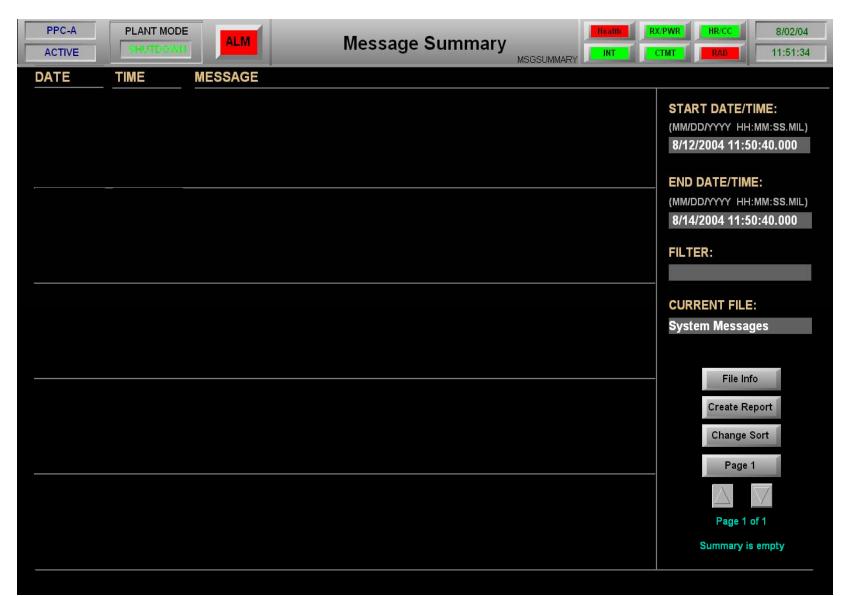


Dynamic Message Summary Display

- Dynamic Message Retrieval Display Features
 - Allows user to see start/end time of the selected file.
 - Allows user to customize aliases for R*TIME System event files.
 - Allows user to customize which System Event file is loaded when coming from a specific display.











Custom Configuration

- Configuration is available via the MsgSummary.ini file. Located in the %RTIMEHOME%\data directory.
- Configuration allows:
 - Aliases on the R*TIME System Event Files.
 - Loading specified files when coming from a default display.





MsgSummry.ini File

*

- * MsgSummary.ini is used to configure the aliases for the SYSTEM EVENT file logs
- * as well as define which file to default to when MsgSummary display is started

*

- * The ALIAS defines the Aliases for the 16 SYSTEM EVENT files
- * This is what is displayed in the Pick list
- * This DISPLAY defines which file to default to when the MsgSummary is started from that specific display
